Mental disorder among criminal defendants affects every stage of the criminal justice process, from investigational issues to competence to be executed.¹ As in all other areas of mental health law, at least some people with mental disorders, especially severe disorders, are treated specially by the criminal law. The Mental Capacity Act (MCA) protects vulnerable people over 16 who are not able to make their own decisions. This section looks at mental capacity law. Mental health legislation is largely used in the management of psychiatric disorders, such as dementia or psychosis, and developmental disabilities where a person does not possess the ability to act in a legally competent manner and requires treatment and/or another person to act in his or her best interests.
