**Downton** Wiltshire. 1822 Jun. CD had a holiday there with his sister Caroline Sarah D.

**Drewe** brother of Edward Drewe; squire of Grange, nr Honiton, Devon.

**Drewe, Adele** see Prévost.

**Drewe, Caroline** see Allen.

**Drewe, Charlotte** ?-c1817. 5c of Edward D. unm.

**Drewe, Edward** 1756–1810. Vicar of Broadhembury, Devon. m 1793 Caroline Allen 2s 5d 1. Harriet Maria, 2. Marianne, 3. Georgiana, 4. Edward Simcoe, 5. Charlotte, 6. Francis, 7. Louisa.

**Drewe, Edward Simcoe** 1805–1877. 4c of Edward D. m. 1828 Adele Prévost and had children. c1820 D inherited The Grange, nr Honiton, Devon.

**Drewe, Gorgiana** c1800–? 3c of Edward D. m 1823 Sir Edward Hall Alderson; mother of *Lady* Salisbury.

**Drewe, Harriet Maria** 179?1857. 1c of Edward D. m 1816 Robert, Lord Clifford and had offspring. 1837 was living at 1 Atholl Crescent, Edinburgh.

**Drewe, Louisa** ?-c1817. 7c of Edward D.

**Drewe, Marianne** 179?–1822. 2c of Edward D. m 1820 Rev. Algernon Langton. Died in childbed.

**Dring** Acting Purser on return of *Beagle* from 2nd voyage.

**Dropmore** Buckinghamshire, 1847 CD visited on day trip from British Association meeting at Oxford.

**Drummond, Rev. J.** Vicar of Downe before Innes. 1842 D sold Down House to CD for £2020.

**Drummond, James** 1763–1863. Botanist of Swan River, W Australia. D helped CD on fertilisation of *Leschenaultia*—MLii 259.

**Drummond, Thomas** 1797–1840. Army engineer & politician. Invented Drummond's light. DNB.

**Drysdale, Lady** ?-c1882 aged nearly 100. Friend of CD & ED through Moor Park Hydro. Dr Lane's mother-in-law.
